Cereal prices especially surged, and the average increase in rice prices was nearly twice as large as wheat prices. The causes of the price shock are complex and unclear, but droughts, rising oil and fertilizer prices, the expansion of biofuels, and increasing demands of a rising global population have all been offered as potential explanations. Whatever the causes, the effects have been dramatic, where as many as 44 million people were driven into food insecurity. This report analyzes food-based coping strategies in response to the food price crisis, and also investigates non-food coping strategies.
